## Overview

In this enquiry the children will explore these questions: Does God want Christians to look after the world? Does the world belong to God? Should people take care of the world? (Believing/Behaving)

## Key Points of Learning

- It is important that the world is looked after.

- It is everyone's responsibility to treat the world with respect



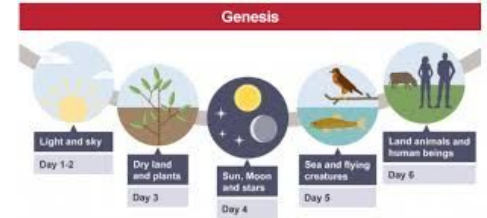
