Science: Holiday (Y1)











In this topic, children will think about what should be packed to go on a trip to the beach, and explore the different animals they might encounter at the seaside and the human impact on the environment. They will take part in an investigation on which material would keep ice cold for longer. Children will think about the impact of human activities on the environment.

This topic covers the following learning objectives:

- I can perform simple tests and use observations to answer questions.
- I can describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.
- I can identify and name common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- I can identify and classify items.
- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
