

# ART: Prehistoric Art

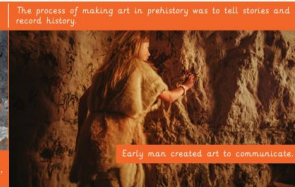


## Overview

Experimenting with charcoal, berries, leaves, homemade paints and more, children get a sense of what it was like to create art thousands of years ago and why these pieces were created.

## Key Points of Learning (RAG at end of each session)

- To scale up drawings and sketches in a different medium
- To apply and blend charcoal to create tone and texture
- To experiment with the pigments in natural products to make different colours
- To develop painting skills
- To collaborate in small or large groups to create a joint piece of artwork
