All parents of the school are automatically members of the WPSA – an independent charity.

We organise fundraising events throughout the year to raise money for the school; we have funded playground improvements and equipment, Chromebooks, enrichment activities and excursions as well as much needed school refurbishments.

There are usually 2 big events each year — the Christmas Fayre and Summer Party (WestFest!). Each year group also organises one additional event for the kids, such as bingo night and kids disco. The events are loved by the children and a great way for the parents to socialise, all whilst raising much needed funds for the school! Each year group also organises one cake sale per year. The events are usually coordinated through the year group 'reps'. The reps also support the WPSA and class teachers in communicating what is going on and arrange social activities for the parents (coffee mornings and pub nights). None of the events can take place without your help, so please volunteer where you can!

We also raise money through the school uniform shop (Mapac) and via easyfundraising shopping plus grant applications where we can.

The WPSA meet once a term; currently this is alternated between a smaller committee meeting (give us a shout if you would like to join) and a wider meeting which everyone is very welcome to come along to. It's very informal and just an opportunity to update on activities and share ideas.
