

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Rationale for School Dress Code

- A school dress code provides an appropriate range of clothing for children to wear in the workshop environment of school.
- A school dress code encourages a sense of belonging to the school. This is important not only in school, but also outside when children are representing the school and are ambassadors for the school.
- A school dress code ensures that children are not distracted from their learning by worrying about wearing or not wearing 'fashionable clothes'.
- A school dress code promotes good habits not only for secondary school but for lifelong learning.

The school colours are grey, green and white and these are also the colours of the school dress code.

Uniform Guidelines

- Sweatshirt, cardigan, jumper or fleece green, with or without the school logo (the PE hoodie may not be worn every day).
- Polo shirt or blouse white, green or grey, with or without the logo.
- Plain charcoal grey trousers, shorts, skirts or dresses.
- Tights should be green, grey or white.
- Summer dresses may be green and white gingham.
- Footwear must be plain black without logos. Brightly coloured trainers are not permitted. Heels should be no more than 1.25 cm higher than the sole. If wellingtons are worn to school a change of footwear should be provided.

PE Uniform Guidelines

- Hoodie or fleece green, with or without the school logo.
- Plain t-shirt in your child's house colours, Rosen is yellow, Rowling is red, Donaldson is blue and Dahl is green, with or without the school logo.
- Plain leggings, shorts or joggers black or grey.
- Suitable weather proof daps or trainers should be worn for outdoor PE.
