

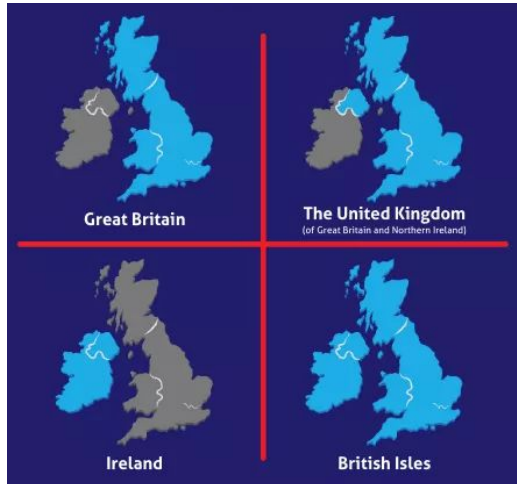
Geography Unit 3: Changes in our Local Environment

Overview
