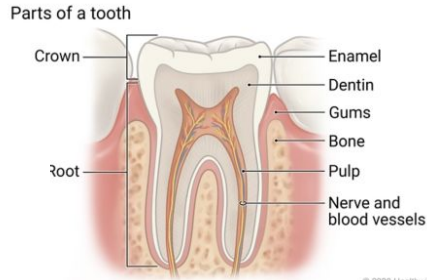


Science: Humans and other animals; Teeth and eating

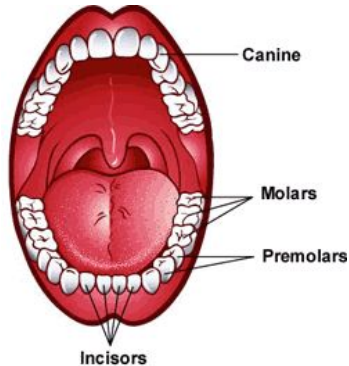
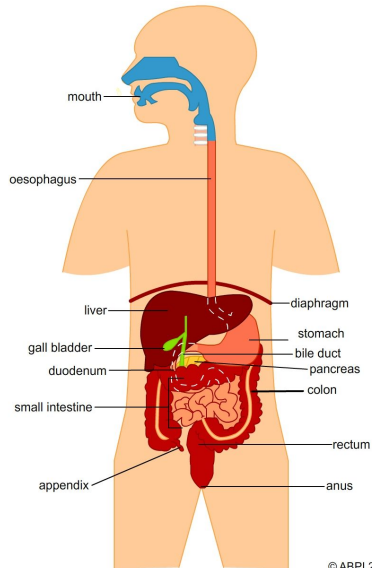
