When should readers move up a stage (Volunteers)?

NB- please use the following guidance as a 'best fit' model. As long as the child can do the majority of the level you want to assess them as, that is fine. For example a child who struggles with working memory may need words and pictures from the book to recall the story but can read with 100% fluency- they should be secure.

Child needs to have read 3 times securely in school before moving onto the next book band.

Developing	Child can -recall what they have read using the words and pictures in the book for prompts - retrieve information from the book -start to reason what a word could mean using the context around it -predict what could happen next in the story	Child can -read approx 80% of the words in the book with phonetic accuracy (this is the equivalent of reading 2 words out of every 10 inaccurately) -generally read fluently -begin to read with expression
Beginning	Child can -recall some of what they have read, using the words and pictures in the book for prompts -retrieve information from the book -begin to think about what individual new words mean - predict-with prompting from an adult- what could happen next in the story	Child can -read approx 60% of the words in the book with phonetic accuracy (this is the equivalent of reading 4 words out of 10 inaccurately) NB if a child cannot read 60% of the words, the book band level is too tricky and they should be moved to a lower band -begin to read with fluency -read with understanding of the purpose of the full stop
