



'Be brave and never give up and if you find something hard, try and try again.'




'Make friends. Don't worry, it's fine to make mistakes. If you find things hard, you can ask a teacher for help.'



Come and Play sessions



- Tuesday 8th July (surnames A-J) and Thursday 10th July (surnames K-Z)
- We will open the large green gates to the KS1 playground at 1.30pm
- Explore our Reception area with your child
- Meet some of the adults who will be working with your child
- 2.30pm finish

- Visit a teacher and a teaching assistant from the EYFS team
- Bring 'Super Me' sheet to share
- Time slot allocated
- Birth certificates needed
- Meet the class bear
- We will take a photo for our family book



The first two weeks



- Children split into Group 1 or Group 2 (alphabetical by first name)
- The welcome letter gives details of which induction group your child will be in
- Children start full time from Monday

Part time days



- Excellent opportunity for staff to really get to know each child
- Quieter, less busy environment for the children to settle into school
- Some whole class time- small teaching times, news, stories, songs
- Time for free play indoors and out
- Time for observation.....find out what the children know, their interests so we can use it to create exciting learning opportunities

Where to drop off/ pick up



Mornings

- Wait at the Key Stage 1 gate.
- 12 noon and 1pm pick ups at the KS1 gates.

Afternoons

- We will open the KS1 gates at 1.30pm
- Collect your child at the end of the day outside in the playground
- We like to hand your child over to you so this can take time at first!

Lunch time at Westbury Park



- Children eat at 12.00 in the hall
- Teaching Assistants and play leaders supervise the children
- Children 'book' lunches in the morning register so make sure they know what they are doing each day and help them decide
- Children can bring a packed lunch from home if preferred (NO NUTS)



What to bring.....



- A book bag
- Named water bottle
- School provides one piece of fruit and carton of milk (milk is free until their 5th birthday)
- One small fruit or vegetable snack if your child prefers a snack from home.
- If home snack, please in an easy to open named tub!
- A set of spare clothes incase of any accidents.





- Toys from home
- Cuddly toys
- Sweets or crisps for snack
- No nut environment



Preparing your child for school We would like your child to....



- Use the toilet independently, including wiping, flushing and washing hands.
- Use a knife and fork effectively.
- Recognise their name.
- Be able to open water bottle/snack/lunch boxes.
- Dress independently including coats, socks and shoes!
